TALKIN TARN 2003 – BEGINNERS CANOEING FOR OUR LADY'S PARISHIONERS AN AFTERNOON OF FUN

Newman School Staff Mr Wadeson (BCU Level 3 Coach) and Mr Richardson (BCU Level 1 Coach) invite Our Lady's Parishioners to an afternoon Canadian canoeing on Talkin Tarn Lake during an afternoon in July or August between 12.00 and 4.00 pm. No experience is required – all training, canoes and safety equipment will be provided. There is a maximum of 10 paddlers in any one session. No charge is made for tuition but participants will be expected to pay £2.50 each towards the cost of boat launching. Participants should be reasonably fit (able to paddle on their knees) and should be aged between 7 and 100.
