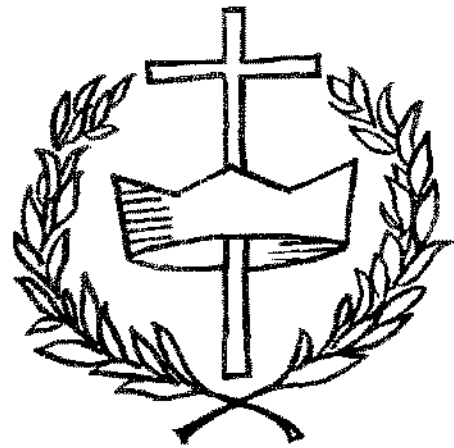
The Building Bridges Project is an attempt to enter into dialogue with young people, to exchange ideas, concerns, knowledge and experience.

IMPORTANT EUTHANASIA CONFERENCE AND PRO-LIFE HANDBOOK

If passed, the government's draft Mental Incapacity Bill will become the first major law in the world allowing euthanasia by neglect. SPUC has organised a major half day conference in London on **Saturday 27th September**, at which leading doctors and lawyers will speak. Also, SPUC has published a *Pro-Life Lobbying Handbook* which explains how people can act effectively against euthanasia and other life threats.
