A variety of matters were dealt with – the Waterton Hall, the Parish Skills Audit, the National Lottery Grant for the promotion of sport in the parish, the Youth Worker project, and the composition of the Parish Pastoral Development Group. You are reminded that today is the last day for nominations for the three vacant places on the PPDG. There are some nomination forms at the back of church. We also looked to the future and how the Church would look in Carlisle in five or ten years' time. It was thought a matter of good planning that we should cooperate with the other parishes in Carlisle in a number of areas and that some sort of inter-parochial or deanery pastoral group should be formed to explore possible solutions to problems of a reduction in clerical personnel, buildings, sharing resources etc. This will be pursued on a deanery level in the near future.
