Our parish has been given a certificate (see the Noticeboard) recognising our status as a parish which promotes justice by making available Fairly Traded goods, allowing producers in the Third World to get an honest return for the work they put into supplying us with tea, coffee, chocolate, clothes, and even computers. Incidentally through the Carlisle One World Centre efforts are being made by all the churches and others to make our city a Fairtrade City. A resolution was passed last week by the City Council supporting this status and a number of outlets for Fairly Traded goods are now available throughout Carlisle. You can learn more about this at the AGM of the One World Centre in the Church of Scotland hall (Chapel St) at 7.30 this next Tuesday.
