MARANATHA COMMUNITY

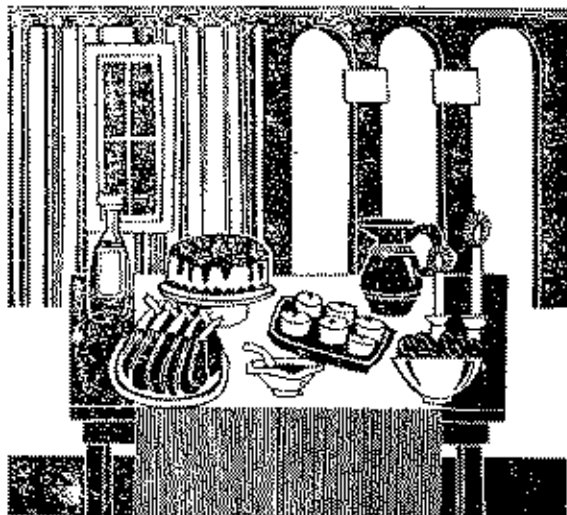
